RULES AND REGULATIONS

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: Office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.

\$25 CHARGE FOR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES: Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership or lease, copies of current ASHA and AHHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

OPEN CHECK: To facilitate office procedures, all exhibitors/trainers are <u>required to leave a blank</u> signed check in the show office before numbers will be released.

REFUNDS: Exhibitors cancelling entries after closing date without a vet certificate shall forfeit their entry fees. *No Refund Of Stall Rent, Office Or Association Fees.* No refunds during show.

FAILURE TO ENTER/SCRATCH: A \$25 fine is charged to any exhibitor who fails to enter or scratch an entry at least one hour prior to the start of performance in which entry would compete.

ARRIVAL: Stalls are available after 3 PM, Tuesday, April 2nd.

STABLING: 10' x 10' wood and metal matted stalls. Electric and water available. <u>No showing out of trailers. Every horse must have a stall.</u>

ASHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Beginning with the 2019 competition year, owners, riders, drivers, handlers and trainers of American Saddlebred horses showing at open shows recorded with ASHA must be current ASHA competing members for points counted for KSF/WCHS Qualifying, National Pleasure and ASHA High Point Awards. Effective February 4, 2019, any individual that appears on the Safe Sport or USEF banned or suspended lists cannot be in attendance, compete or participate in such competition in any manner, including as a trainer, coach, owner or exhibitor of horses or ponies.

ALL HORSES: Horses coming into Iowa must have a Health Certificate and negative Coggins for Equine Infectious Anemia within the prior 12 months, and proof of Rhinopneumonitis (Rhino/flu) vaccination within 6 months of entering stables.

"JACKPOT" STAKES: Open to all; no prior qualification required to enter Jackpot class.

STAKE/CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY: For regular Stake and Championship classes horse/pony must be entered, shown and judged in class in same section. To qualify for Amateur, Adult or Junior Exhibitor Stake/Championship, horse/pony must have been shown in a class in the same section by an amateur or junior exhibitor.

"DENVER JUNIOR HORSE" CLASS: For horses five years and under. It originated at the Denver National Western Stock Show, annually held in January, and is most appropriate for use at shows held early in the year, such as Spring Fling.

PRIZES OFFERED: Trophy and Ribbons, 1st through 6th place will be awarded in all classes, with the exception of UPHA classes. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 8th place.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED

RING SIZES, FOOTING: Show ring is 100' x 200', warm-up is 88' x 120'. Footing for both rings is masonry sand. Totally enclosed, fully heated facility, rubber matted stalls.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT: Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following terms and conditions: The Mid-America Spring Fling Horse Show, Mid-America Horse Show Association, Equestrian Center, show management and sponsors will be in no case responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold them blameless for any loss or injury which may occur by fire, theft or otherwise.
