# Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk And Indemnity Agreement

READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING IT. YOUR SIGNATURE INDICATES YOU UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO ITS TERMS. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU (AND YOUR CHILD) ARE GIVING UP CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in the Saddle Up Youth Horsemanship Weekend, each of the undersigned, for himself/herself, any minor children for whom he/she is parent, legal guardian, or otherwise responsible and for his/her/their heirs, personal representatives, and next of kin:

- 1. Acknowledge that horseback riding is an inherently dangerous activity and involves risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases death, because of the unpredictable nature and behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance.
- 2. Acknowledge under Iowa Law, a domesticated animal is not liable for damages suffered by, an injury to, or the death of a participant resulting from the inherent risks of domesticated animal activities, pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 673
- 3. Hereby releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue Kirkwood Community College, the Iowa Equestrian Center, any subdivision of Kirkwood Community College, owners and lessees of any premises used in the Saddle Up Youth Horsemanship Weekend, employees of Kirkwood Community College and agents of Kirkwood Community College, all herein referred to as "Releasees," FROM ALL LIABILITY TO THE UNDERSIGNED, HIS/HER PERSONAL REPRESETATIVE, ASSIGNS, HEIRS AND NEXT OF KIN FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFOR ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE EVENTS OF THE SADDLE UP YOUTH HORSEMANSHIP WEEKEND AT THE IOWA EQUESTRIAN CENTER, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLEGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
- 4. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES AND EACH OF THEM FROM ANY LOSS, LIABILITY, DAMAGE OR COST THEY MAY INCUR ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE EVENTS OF SADDLE UP YOUTH HORSEMANSHIP WEEKEND AT THE IOWA EQUESTRIAN CENTER, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEE OR OTHERWISE.
- 5. Acknowledges that this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of the Risk and Indemnity Agreement shall cover any and all acts during the entire Saddle Up Youth Horsemanship Weekend at the Iowa Equestrian Center.
- 6. Acknowledge the undersigned have read and understand the Saddle Up Youth Horsemanship Weekend Rules and Regulations.
- 7. Acknowledge that it is mandatory for all riders to wear a helmet during all English riding classes; it is strongly recommended a helmet be worn at all times by any person participating in Saddle Up Youth Horsemanship Weekend.

I HAVE READ THE FOREGOING, FULLY UNDERSTAND THE TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY AND INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.
