### Iowa Equestrian Center Rules/Regulations:

- No smoking in any buildings.
- All pets must be on a leash.
- No parking on grass.
- All trailers and vehicles must be parked in designated areas.
- All fire lanes must be kept clear.
- Manure disposal in designated areas only.

### Stabling:

- All stalls/tack stalls are **\$100.00**
- Payment must accompany stall requests.
- Stalls will be available after 8:00 am May 14th.
- All horses entered must purchase a stall.
- Horses arriving prior to Thursday need to contact Nancy Weber for approval.
- Early Arrival Fee - \$15.00 if arriving before 8:00 am Thur.

### Bedding:

- All bedding must be purchased from Iowa Equestrian Center.
- Please order bedding with your entries. A minimum **two bags** per horse must be ordered with entries.
- Shavings will be delivered to stalls prior to arrival.

### Hay & Grain:

- Both hay and grain will be available for purchase at the show. Please order hay with your entries.

### Stake/Championship Eligibility:

- To be eligible for competition in a divisional stake or championship, a horse must be shown and judged in one other class in that division.
- For an Amateur/Junior Exhibitor Stake, a horse must have shown and been judged in an amateur or junior exhibitor qualifying class.
- Open Pleasure classes do not qualify a horse for ASB Show Pleasure, ASB Country Pleasure, ASB Western Pleasure, ASB Hunter, or Morgan Pleasure Championships.

### Open Pleasure Division:

- Can be shown by amateur or professional.
- Open to any breed.
- Open classes do not qualify horses for other divisional stakes/championships.

### Academy Classes:

- Limited to beginner and intermediate riders who have only shown in Academy classes. For additional rules and guidelines for the Academy Classes please refer to the Iowa Horse Show Association Academy Division Rules available at <http://iowahorseshowsassociation.com/>

### Entry Fees:

- Performance, Equitation, Academy: **\$25.00**
- Performance & Academy Championships: **\$30.00**
- Entries due April 25th. All other entries received after April 25th please add a late entry fee of **\$25.00** per horse. Post entries do not apply to Championship or Stake classes.



All out of state horses must have a negative Coggins test within the past 12 months.



All out of state horses must have a health certificate dated within 30 days.



All horses must be vaccinated for EHV1 prior to the show.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition [Great River Benefit Horse Show] to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (“Harm”).

I AGREE to release the Iowa Horse Show Association and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Iowa Horse Show Association or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Iowa Horse Show Association or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Iowa Horse Show Association and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child’s participation and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child’s behalf.

I AGREE that “the Iowa Horse Show Association” and “Competition” as used above includes all of the officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Iowa Horse Show Association on the official accident/injury report form. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.
