


We Have Missed You!

COVID-19 UPDATES for IEC Guests

The health and safety of our guests, students and employees continues to be our top priority. As Kirkwood Community College begins the process of welcoming the public back on campus, the Iowa Equestrian Center shall implement the procedures and protocols outlined below. These protocols must be effectively met for events to resume successfully at Kirkwood Community College's Iowa Equestrian Center. We appreciate your patience, diligence and care as we work together to ensure events can take place safely and responsibly.

What to Expect at the IEC

- All Employees will follow Kirkwood Community College's Staff Safety Protocols, which can be viewed at: http://www.kirkwood.edu/site/index.php?p=41721
 which includes wearing a face covering.
- Regular disinfecting by misting or wiping down of common touch points, such as gate latches and door handles.
- IEC staff will disinfect handles, shifters and steering wheels on shared equipment after each use.
- Restrooms will be closed on a rotational schedule throughout the day to allow for disinfecting.
- Water fountains will be disabled.
- IEC staff will perform a deep cleaning of the facility between each event.
- IEC staff will serve guests while maintaining **six feet of social distance**. Only if absolutely necessary will IEC staff work in closer proximities. IEC staff will ask, and if necessary remind, guests to maintain 6 feet of distance from one another.
- IEC employees pledge to practice frequent hand washing and self-health assessments. To the best of their knowledge,
 IEC employees reporting to work are in good health and are not experiencing any flu-like symptoms.

What We Expect of Our Guests

- All guests, whether participating in and event, or attending to support an individual that is participating, must sign the IEC Waiver and Release of Liability upon entering the IEC Grounds.
- All guests are to follow Kirkwood Community College's Safety Protocols, which can be viewed at:
 https://www.kirkwood.edu/backtocampus which includes wearing a face covering when you are inside the IEC and are not competing or are not mounted on a horse.
- Social distance of six feet of separation must be maintained. Guests are to avoid congregate settings or concentration of individuals in a single area and shall **maintain a minimum of six feet** from others unless absolutely impossible.
- Attendees are to adhere to Kirkwood Community College, IEC and Event Organizer protocols. Noncompliance can result in removal of individuals or a premature ending of a riding session or event.
- Guests are held responsible for disinfecting and wiping down high-touch surfaces, including stall door latches in their stabling area, shared grooming tools, tack and equipment. Guests are expected to bring and use a disinfectant of their choice.
- Guests are to wash their hands with soap and water frequently and use hand sanitizer available in the stalling areas, office locations and arenas. Guests shall not attend if they are experiencing any flu-like symptoms or have been in contact with anyone testing positive for COVID-19.
