Show Information

Stalls: Horse Stalls \$80 (includes 2 bags shavings)/Tack Stalls \$64 if reserved/paid (postmarked) on or by July 11

Horse Stalls \$90 (includes 2 bags shavings)/Tack Stalls \$74 if reserved/paid (postmarked) July 12 & later

All horses must have a stall, no jumpouts allowed. a \$100 stall fee per horse will be charged to anyone caught jumping out

Office Fee: \$5/horse

Shavings: \$8.00/bag (2 bag minimum required by the facility in all horse stalls)

Entry Fees: **Regular Class:** \$6/class (50%office/50% payback)

Jackpot Class: \$10/class (50%office/50% payback)

STARS Class: \$4/class

Camping: \$25/night, first come/first serve, no prepayment necessary (Electric service only)

ONLINE RESERVATIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE JUNE 17, 2022. Stall Reservations will be done on a first paid-first served basis.

If you want specific stalls or an area, you need to reserve those early & pay a \$5/stall special request fee.

*The barns will be open to move in Friday morning by 10am, earlier arrivals are discouraged, but if needed you **must** make previous arrangements with Martha, your early arrival is subject to IEC's approval & you will be charged an additional \$15/day fee.

***STARS Classes-\$4 entry, prizes, no payback, handlers &/or coaches ARE allowed & encouraged to be in the show pen during the class.**

****STARS LEAD-LINE:** All riders participating in the Lead-line are NOT eligible for any other riding class other than the STARS classes.

***2 YEAR OLD LONGE LINE**-only other riding class horse can show in is 2 & 3 year old Walk-Trot.

***W/T HORSEMANSHIP**-Horse/rider combo **cannot** do Jackpot Horsemanship or regular Youth/Adult Horsemanship.

*All ages (horse & exhibitor) are as of Jan. 1, 2022

*Stallions must be handled & ridden by persons 19 years old or older

*A fall of a rider is considered a DQ & is required to exit the arena

*Western tack required unless otherwise noted

*The show committee reserves the right to split or combine classes

*All exhibitors or legal guardians must sign the release of liability prior to showing

*The Grinnell Saddle Club & The Iowa Equestrian Center are not responsible in case of accidents, injury, illness &/or theft

*Exhibitors/Spectators may not approach the judge until the conclusion of the show; any concerns can be addressed to the show management

*Class payback will be awarded thru 6th place using the following scale (including added money): 27%, 21%, 18%, 15%, 12%, 7%

***Please pre-enter if possible using the link on our website & Facebook page,** then you will just need to bring an open check to the office & verify your entries at that time. This will save you a lot of time & reduce lines at the show office.
