WEEKEND AWARDS

High Point Horse & Exhibitor Combination

Top 2 Places awarded prizes in each division, Youth, Adult & STARS classes

Must show to both judges for the weekend. Points calculated using the 9 point scale & are figured per horse/exhibitor combination. Prizes awarded after the show on Sunday each weekend.

All classes labeled as "Youth" or "Adult" will count in the points along with all halter classes except Jackpot Halter. Only STARS classes will count towards the STARS awards, this does not include Lead Line or any halter classes.

Reservations open on January 3, 2022.

Show Information

Stalls: If reserved/paid (postmarked) by February 14 for 2/26-27 show, February 28 for 3/12-13 show, March 21 for 4/2-3 show Horse Stalls \$80 (includes 2 bags shavings)/Tack Stalls \$64

If reserved/paid (postmarked) by February 15 for 2/26-27 show, March 1 for 3/12-13 show, March 22 for 4/2-3 show or later for each show Horse Stalls \$90 (includes 2 bags shavings)/Tack Stalls \$74

NEW THIS YEAR: Due to demand for specific stalls, there will be a \$5/stall special request fee. Special requests will be granted in order payment is received, if you want certain stalls you will need to send in your stall reservations early!!! (this money will be used towards awards for the show)

All horses must have a stall, no jumpouts allowed, 1 horse/pony/stall a \$100 stall fee will be charged to anyone caught jumping out

Office Fee: \$10/horse/weekend Shavings: \$8.00/bag (2 bag minimum required by the facility in all horse stalls)

Regular Classes & Lead-line: \$6/class

Jackpot Classes: \$10/class (50%office/50% payback) STARS Classes: \$5/class

<u>Camping:</u> \$25/night, first come/first serve, no prepayment necessary (Electric service only)

*STARS Classes-\$5 entry, handlers &/or coaches ARE allowed & encouraged to be in the show pen during the class.

**LEAD-LINE: All riders participating in the Lead-line are NOT eligible for any other riding class other than the other TROPHY riding classes

*2 YEAR OLD LONGE LINE-only other riding class horse can show in is 2 & 3 year old Walk-Trot.

*Indoor arena will be available by noon on Friday.

*All ages (horse & exhibitor) are as of Jan. 1, 2022

*All horses are considered to have a birthday on Jan. 1, 2022

*Western tack required unless otherwise noted

*Stallions must be handled & ridden by persons 19 years old or older

- *The show committee reserves the right to split or combine classes
- *A fall of a rider is considered a DQ & is required to exit the arena
- *All exhibitors or legal guardians must sign the release of liability prior to showing
